NOTICE OF SPECIAL RESOLUTION

For many years the Greenwich Community Association has maintained a public liability insurance policy for a limit of \$5million. The cost of maintaining this insurance is significant relative to our annual subscription income.

The Associations Incorporation Act no longer requires associations such as ours to maintain public liability insurance.

A special resolution will be put to the next general meeting to remove from our Rules the requirement to maintain public liability insurance and to insert a provision giving the Executive discretion as to whether such cover is required.

Notices of the proposed form of resolution will be displayed in mid-January.
