SPECIAL RESOLUTION TO CHANGE THE RULES OF THE GREENWICH COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

Resident may have noticed signs around the area advising that a resolution will be put to our February meeting to change the Rules of the Association.

Just a bit of history ...for many years the Association has been maintaining public liability insurance cover to a level of \$10 million. This insurance does not come cheaply. Last year our premium was \$600 which represents 25 % of our annual income from subscriptions.

The law originally required the Association to maintain public liability insurance but now this cover is optional. Individual associations can decide if it is required. The committee of the Association has concluded that the nature of the Association's activities does not create a need for public liability cover. At our December meeting it was resolved to proceed to change the Rules of the Association to give the Association discretion as to the insurance cover it effects.

Changes to the Rules may only be made through passing a Special Resolution. Informal notice of the intention to move this resolution was given in our December newsletter and, as required by the Rules, formal

notices were placed on public noticeboards in January. The resolution to be put to the February General Meeting is as follows:

"That Rule 33 of the Rules of Greenwich Community Association Incorporated be amended by deleting Rule 33 in its entirety and replacing it with the following:-

33. The association may effect and maintain insurance'."
