GREENWICH SHOPPING PRECINCT PROJECT

The first stage of the Greenwich Shopping Precinct upgrade is nearing completion. We must remember when we next need rainfall that a shopping precinct upgrade seems to do the trick! The planting and installation of street furniture near the school gate has been completed – this will be followed by sealing of the pavement. A powder coated railing will be erected behind the landscaped area adjacent to the school gate on 19th August. The community consultation process undertaken last year has resulted in a greatly enhanced public space and we now look forward to the second stage of the project.

SHELL REFINING GORE BAY TERMINAL

Shell Refining has decided that it will close its refining operations at Clyde by mid 2013. The Gore Bay terminal will be converted into a competitive product import terminal after the Clyde operation has ceased.

As has been the case for many years, Shell is keen to engage with the Greenwich community in the planning of operations at the terminal. Shell is hosting an information session for local residents at Lane Cove Country Club on Monday 15th August at 7pm where residents will have the opportunity to ask questions. This session will be part of an on-going community consultation process planned by Shell. Several members of the Greenwich Community Association Committee will attend the meeting and will report back to our public meeting on Wednesday 17th August.
