GREENWICH POINT BUSH TRACK

As many of you would know, the track between the ferry wharf and Shell Park has been closed for some time now because of a dangerous rockfall.

Council's initial plan was to bring in a huge 30-tonne excavator to carry out the restoration work. This would obviously have been extremely costly and finding the funds has delayed the repairs.

Fortunately, a re-assessment of the situation has now determined that a much smaller excavator will be able to manage the job. This will not only be less costly but will cause less damage to the sensitive surrounding bushland.

The work is expected to start in 2 to 3 weeks and should take a similar time to complete.

The excavator will need to be brought in by barge. So, if you have a dinghy secured at the small beach nearby, please contact Council because your boat may have to be temporarily moved elsewhere to avoid damage.

Boat owners should always be careful about how dinghies are secured. Over time, chaining boats to the trees causes ringbarking. So please remove boat chains when they are no longer needed.

We have asked Council to consider fixing some steel posts in the ground as alternative anchor points.
